Immunizations: Yesterday was the deadline to turn in our forms! We have many forms still out. Every year a **NEW** form **MUST** be filled out regardless if your child has received new shots or not. We must have the signed lilac form on file for each child enrolled. If you have not turned in your forms...today you will receive a legal notice from the Department of Health Services that you are non-compliant which may result in a \$25.00 per day fine. If we do not have your forms returned by **October 1**st you will get a notice of exclusion. The final deadline for compliance is **October 8**th. If your forms are not on file in the school office by October 9th your child will be excluded from school.

Accreditation: The accreditation process continues at Good Shepherd's. We have scheduled our school visitation for accreditation. The visitation team will be at Good Shepherd's April 8th-10th. The steering committee has met and has put together a time line for finishing accreditation. We will be meeting with our different sub committees by October 1st to figure out what items still need to be completed. MAP Testing at Good Shepherd's: Over the next two weeks the 5K through 8th grade students at Good Shepherd's will be taking the standardized test called the Measure of Academic Progress (MAP). This test is an internet based test that is taken entirely on the computer and will also be taken in the winter and in the spring. This will help us to better track the academic progress of our students. Each teacher will be sending home a note this Friday telling you which days their classroom will be testing.

<u>Help Wanted!</u> The flooring at school is almost finished. It is time to shift our focus over to church's carpeting.
